## **Itinerary**

**Day 1** Today let the excitement build as we fly from Southern California to **Seattle**, Washington. Enjoy the beautiful, lush greenery as the plane makes its approach. We will make our way to **Vancouver, BC** to start our adventures with a welcome dinner this evening. Hotel accommodations for the next 2 nights will in Vancouver. (D)

A highlight of any visit to Victoria, have your cameras ready for stunning photos. In the late afternoon we go to **Sydney** to catch the ferry destined for **Friday Harbor**. As we sail, keep an eye open for local wildlife such as soaring eagles and diving orcas. Upon arrival we will check into our hotel for 3 nights in this picturesque town. (B)

**Day 5** You will certainly delight in today's tour to the historic **Roche Harbor Resort, Sculpture Park**, the **English Camp** and the **Alpaca Farm**, with an afternoon **cruise** of the **San Juan Islands**. Upon our return you may want to visit the **Whale Museum** the first U.S. Museum dedicated to a species living in the wild, the Orca. Evening is at your leisure. (B)

**Day 6.** Today we tour the **American Camp**, and **Lavender Farm** on the island. There will be time to browse and wander the quaint Friday Harbor stores, boutiques and galleries upon our return. Enjoy socializing at our hosted farewell dinner tonight. (B, D)

**Day 7** A morning ferry back to the mainland starts our journey home. We'll get you to the Seattle-Tacoma Airport for your flight home, as you say good bye to all your new friends. (B)
