Day 1 Your journey begins in downtown Seattle, where your home-away-from-home will be at the **Hyatt House Hotel Seattle/Downtown**. Day 2 Today we spend the morning at the beauty of **Snoqualmie Falls**. We will walk the trail to view one of Washington's most popular sights. Located conveniently close to the Falls is a 2-acre park, an observation deck to enhance your view, and the gift shop. Our next stop of the day includes a wine tasting and tour at the **Chateau Ste. Michelle** where wine and heritage intersect into an unforgettable experience. After wine tasting, conclude the afternoon by enjoying a nice, casual lunch at Red Hook Brewery, with a short tour. In the afternoon, we return to the hotel giving you some leisure time. **L**

Day 3 We transition from land to water by hopping aboard the **Victoria Clipper to Friday Harbor**, located in the San Juan Islands.
