**Day 1, Oct 12** - Today we fly to Nashville, Tennessee “America’s Country Music Capitol of the World.” Upon arrival, you will be taken to your hotel. **Gaylord Opryland Hotel Resort** features nine acres of indoor botanical gardens under a climate-controlled glass atrium, complete with rivers, pathways, and waterfalls.

**Day 2, Oct. 13 - The Country Music Hall of Fame and Museum** contains exhibits, films, interactive displays and costumes as well as instruments and lyric sheets. This museum identifies and preserves the evolving history and traditions of country music. We will visit **The Hermitage**, Home of President Andrew Jackson, the seventh president of the United States. The beloved Hermitage Mansion is a self - guided tour with costumed historical interpreters throughout the home. You can see a short film on the life of President Andrew Jackson, the lovely gardens, the Hermitage Church, and the Tulip Grove Mansion. We return to our beautiful hotel to freshen up. This evening we will attend the **Grand Ole Opry**. This is the country's longest running live radio show, and has not missed a broadcast since the beginning of 1925. The shows can offer bluegrass, comedy and gospel artists as well as many well-known country music stars. (B, D)

**Day 3, Oct 14** - Visit the **Johnny Cash Museum**, new to Nashville, a journey of the life and music career of the "Man in Black". Exhibits and collections include stage costumes, instruments, artwork, handwritten lyrics and sounds of his music. You remember his music by some of the titles like: Walk the Line, Folsom Prison Blues, Ring of Fire and so many more. Upstairs in the museum building is the **Patsy Cline Museum**. You would remember Patsy from the Golden Globe winning picture of "Coal Miner's Daughter". She was a vocal stylist who embraced country music and pop sounds before rock in roll came about. Cline scored hits with "Walking After Midnight", "I Fall to Pieces", and "Crazy". Dinner is planned for this evening. (B, D)

**Day 4, Oct 15** - Today we travel from Nashville, TN through Kentucky into Branson, MO. See the country side of Tennessee, Kentucky and the Missouri with its beautiful Ozark Mountains. (B, D)



**Day 5, Oct 16** - This morning our first Branson Show is at The **Dutton Family Theater**. Swaying, clapping, singing along is what Branson is all about with every one of their shows. Next a City tour of Branson and a visit to the **College of the Ozarks**. Then a stop at the **Stone Hill Winery** to enjoy a tour and Spumante and Sherry tasting. This evening's show will be the **Hughes Brothers** and their family with vocal harmonies, dancing and musical instruments. (B, D)

**Day 6, Oct 17 - The Buck Trent Morning Country Music Show** has a lot of musical energy to begin your day. Next we will board the **Showboat Branson Belle**, an 1890's paddle wheeler that cruises on Table Rock Lake with lunch and an entertaining show. This evening's show is **Clay Cooper's Country Music Show** with live music, and singing, and dancing.(B, L)



**Day 7, Oct 18** - This morning we'll have breakfast before departing for home. After this tour, music will still be "singing" in our hearts and souls. (B)
